As a former domestic violence advocate, Dr. Candace Burton became a nurse in the hopes of increasing understanding of the impact of relationship-based abuse on women's health. Dr. Burton holds a BA and BSN from the University of Virginia, and PhD from the University of California, San Francisco. Her research centers on increasing understanding of the impact of relationship-based abuse on women's health, including intimate partner abuse, sexual assault, and the relationships of these to health disparities, especially with regard to reproductive and sexual health. She has specific interest in biobehavioral research approaches, particularly at the intersection of psychosocial and physiologic responses. You are invited to hear Dr. Burton speak about her work, her new role at UC-Irvine School of Nursing and where she sees relationship-based abuse on women's health today.

Dr. Kathleen Mullen's program of research focuses on nurses' work and their well-being. She received her PhD in Nursing from UC, San Francisco, MSN from San Francisco State University, and BSN *cum laude* from the University of Michigan, Ann Arbor. She is a professor at Dominican University of California, San Rafael, and since 2006 has been an assistant clinical professor at the University of California, San Francisco. Currently, she is studying the perception of work-life balance in hospital-based nurses from a variety of clinical settings across the United States. Her thoughtful, qualitative research has been selected for publication and presentation at a wide variety of national and international professional nursing conferences.
