

## Important BLS Renewal Changes!

New AHA BLS renewal process effective Wednesday, September 1, 2021:

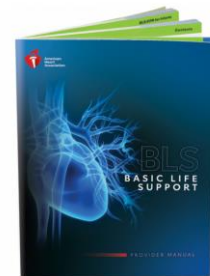
- NO BLS prework required for recertifications!
- NO certificate to print and bring to class - Just register, grab a book and go!
- NO HealthStream module required
- NO changes to the current processes for compensation for this training
- Streamlined registration – Go directly to NCTI Website and sign-up. That's it!
- Only 2.5H for BLS recertifications vs. 4H for New or Expired BLS Class

➤ **Who: Impacts BLS Renewals** moving forward

- *Not applicable for New or Expired BLS certifications*
- *No change in existing ACLS/PALS Process*

➤ **Why? NO pre-work required – streamlined to support employees**

- Single-step registration on NCTI's Website –

- AHA BLS Providers Manual required:
  - *Beginning 9/1/21, NCTI Instructors will have limited books available during this transition*
  - *If you want your own copy, books are also available for purchase*
  - *Collaborating on options to offer books for local sign out*
- Class duration 2.5 hours – Includes video, skills validation, open-book test
- 2-3 sessions available per scheduled day
- COVID social distancing and safety guidelines remain in effect
- Indefinite change, BLS recertification process will continue post-pandemic
