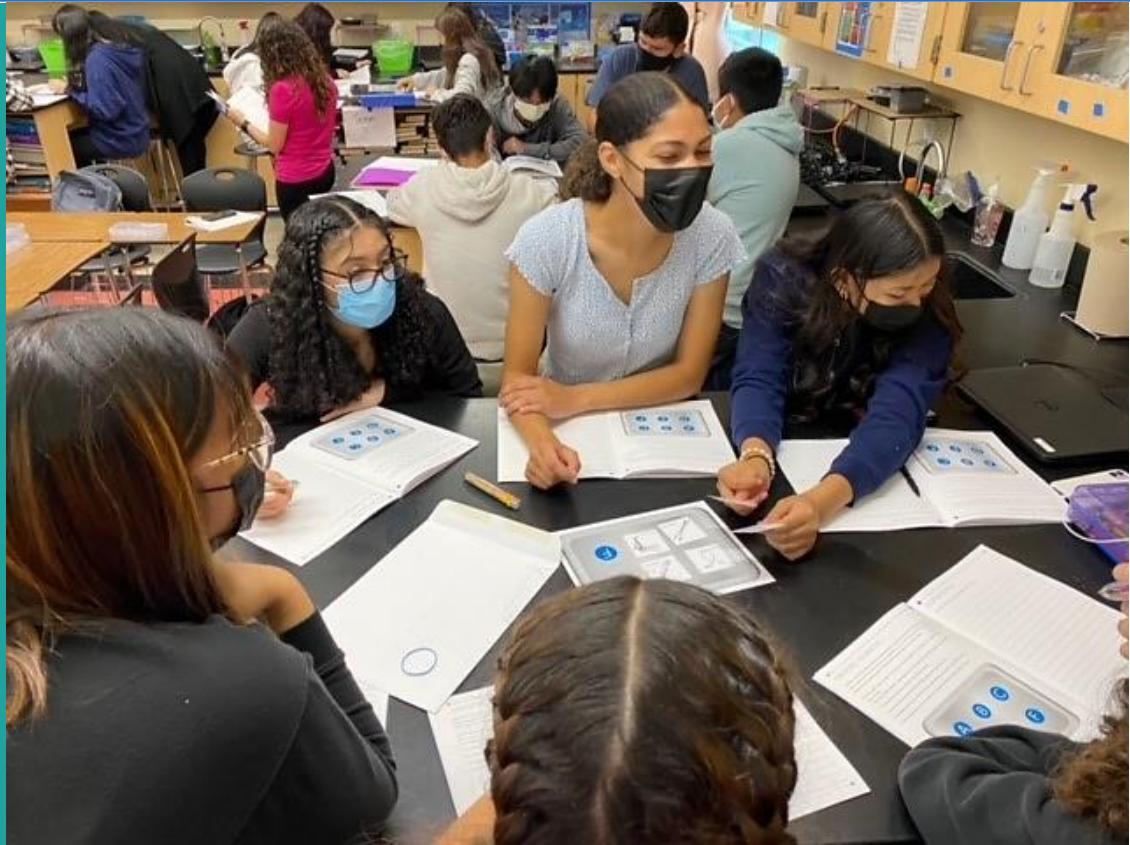


Kaiser Permanente Northern California Scholars Academy is excited to announce

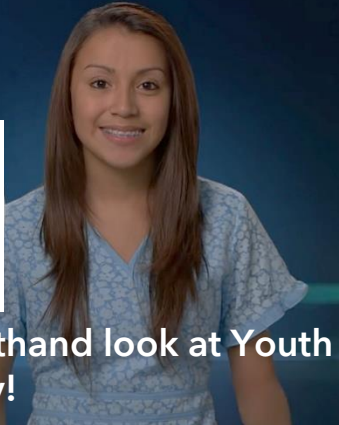
