PCT Minimum Qualifications

- Candidates must have completed <u>one semester in a clinical setting as a student nurse</u> or have a minimum of 6 months of experience in a hospital, clinic or SNF/Home Health setting as a nurse assistant, care partner or medical assistant
- Basic Life Support card through American Heart Association (AHA) required upon hire
- We do not require a CNA certification or course to work as a PCT

Important Considerations

- Starting pay is \$32.67 \$34.38/hour
- Our positions range in scheduled hours from on call to 20-40 hours per week
 - Many positions are around 24 hours a week, allowing for a flexible work schedule
 - o Positions available across our 21 NCAL hospitals and new jobs open throughout the year
- Benefits are offered to all employees who work 20+ hours per week including Tuition Reimbursement to help offset the cost of education expenses including books
- We prioritize existing KP employees in our Nurse Residency screening process, especially those in direct patient care roles and those who have longer tenure with KP
