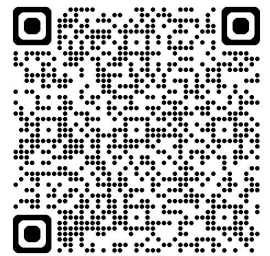
Trang Pham joined the U.S. Army, serving shortly after 9/11. She has a background in Pediatric Intensive Care, Emergency Medicine and Trauma, and Perianesthesia Nursing. She has been a Family Violence Champion since 2019. After listening to a patient's story about how they were forced to use drugs and enter "the life", she became involved in anti-trafficking and patient advocacy.

Trang was a member of the Sacramento Coalition Against Human Trafficking, a panelist in the San Francisco Collaborative Against Human Trafficking, volunteered with Code Red, and keeps herself in touch with patient advocates through My Sister's House.
