Foundations of Evidence-Based Practice (EBP) Workshop

In partnership with the UCSF Leadership Institute, the KP Scholars Academy is excited to offer the Foundations of Evidence-Based Practice (EBP) Workshop for frontline care providers and professional governance leaders. This 3-day workshop engages participants in an innovative educational experience focused on facilitating an evidence-based approach to searching for and critically appraising a body of evidence.

The Foundations of EBP Workshop includes three in-person sessions as well as some pre-work. Following completion of the workshop, participants will be able to:

- Explain how EBP plays an integral role in hospitals and health care systems.
- Examine the differences between EBP, Quality Improvement (QI), EBQI, and Research.
- Identify the seven steps of the EBP process.
- Apply the elements of a PICO(T) question as a tool to search for a body of evidence to answer a clinical question.
- Develop basic search strategies to conduct a systematic search.
- Distinguish between sources of evidence and how to utilize bibliographic databases.
- Differentiate research designs of quantitative and qualitative studies.
- Discover the process for critically appraising a body of evidence.
- Construct evidence-based recommendations through the use of evaluation and synthesis tables.

Participants must commit to all three sessions and are required to attend all three sessions in full to complete the course. This program is limited to 24 participants.

Day 1 (April 14, 2026): Focuses on EBP steps 0-2 including cultivating a culture of inquiry, identifying the problem, and searching the literature.

Day 2 (April 15, 2026): Focuses on EBP step 3, part 1 by guiding participants through critical appraisal of the evidence, including distinguishing between quantitative and qualitative research designs and its correlating levels of evidence.

Day 3 (April 16, 2026): Focuses on EBP step 3, part 2 by evaluating the 3 criteria for assessing the quality of the evidence: validity, reliability, and applicability, in addition to the use of evaluation and synthesis tables.
